Overview

The **MISSIONS INTENSIVE** is more than a missions trip. This is for someone who is looking to be trained for long-term missions. In 13 weeks students learn through missions academics, receiving hands-on ministry experience at the same time. You learn missions while you are doing missions. We start with what God has already put in your heart and then we equip you and show you how to walk out that passion and calling. All of this is done in a safe, cross-cultural learning and living environment on the beautiful island of Trinidad. The goal of the Missions Intensive is to help you begin the adventure of a lifetime of partnering with God to touch His world.

While in Trinidad students will learn:

- How to live cross culturally
- Effective cross-cultural ministry
- To design and lead mission's trips
- To target countries and design effective ministry for that country
- To develop a support structure for their ministry
- To use compassion ministries to reach the world
- To learn and experience Spirit led and empowered ministry
- To study missions academics
- Initial language acquisition in the language of your choice
- An overview of world religions
- As well as personalized one-on-one time with missionaries Mike and Pam Lumbard

While in Trinidad students will be involved in hands-on ministries such as:

- Soup Kitchen
- Children's Home
- Squatter Community
- A Church in a Hindu community
- Youth and Children's Ministries
- Ministries and services in a variety of Churches
- Community outreaches

Directors

Mike and Pam Lumbar have lived in Trinidad for 8 years as missionaries with the purpose of training future missionaries. They have hosted over 230 people who have come on trips to Trinidad from North America as well as people from 13 other nations that have stayed in their home.

Cost

\$3,000 USD + a plane ticket

This includes all books and academics, housing, meals, ministry and transportation from the time you land in Trinidad until you leave. This price does not include personal spending money or personal toiletry items.

It is your responsibility to purchase a round-trip ticket to Trinidad (airport code: POS). Please plan to arrive and depart on the dates listed above.
